- 1. <u>Heb 5:11-6:3</u> What is the reason the author gives for not proceeding with his exposition of the High Priesthood of Christ that he had begun?
 - a. What does he say is the condition of those to whom he is writing?
 - b. What specific charges does he direct toward them?
 - c. Why do you think they are the way they are?
 - d. Do any of these descriptions resemble your own spiritual life?
- 2. Apostasy? **Verses 6:4-6** are among the most highly contested scriptures in the New Testament.
 - a. What are the warnings the author presents here?
 - b. What are the implications of this teaching?
 - c. (Challenge Question) Is there significance in the fact that the author moves from the first to the third person in verse 4? How does Verse 9 help you interpret verses 4-8?
- 3. Perseverance? How do verses 9-12 help clarify the message the writer is conveying in this section? How do these verses encourage or convict you personally?
- 4. Why has the author of Hebrews given us the story of Abraham in 6:13-15? How would you describe the anchor of your soul (cf. 6:19)?
