Last week Paulo Sergio reported that the ESI Facilitator Training he led in Sierra Leone went well. Many pastors reported how God used the time together studying the Bible to encourage them in their walk in God. Many made the decision to study the Bible and form ESI groups to meet weekly over the next 3 years to encourage one another in their walk in Christ. I am thankful that Payne Mano (our ESI leader in Zambia) and pastor S (we will be working with him in Ethiopia, Somalia, Eritrea in April) and pastor Derek Thomas (ESI London) were able to be with Paulo to learn how to lead ESI Facilitator Trainings!

Elias Montelage told me that the ESI Facilitator Training last week went well in Minas Gerais, Brazil. We thank God for the way He is using Paulo Sergio and Elias to move new work forward in Brazil and Africa!

Would you please pray for the next 2 weeks in Liberia? I will travel with Pastor Jeff Port and Wes Croft on Monday, joining William Tarpeh and Paulo Sergio in Monrovia to lead 2 ESI Facilitator Training Retreats there November 29-December 2, and in Harper December 2-9. Please pray that God will impact the 210 Liberian pastors who will participate, that they will see their need to be focused on Jesus and His Word, and to experience gospel transformation in their lives.

Please also pray for Paulo Sergio and Elias leading an ESI Facilitator Training in the Portuguese speaking African country of Guinea-Bissau December 13-16, and also for the follow-up that Paulo Sergio and Vania will be doing in Kigali, visiting the ESI groups that started in Rwanda.
