People frequently ask "How do you pick the songs that you sing in your worship services?"

- We try to be very consistent in using songs that are theologically TRUE and have a measure of depth- songs that speak of who God is, and of His attributes, rather than our own experience, and that are not too repetitive or "fluffy".
- A singable melody that is attainable for the congregation is very important, as is the key placement of the song. The easiest key for some of the band is not always an achievable congregational key, due to the placement of the melody and vocal range. We do consistently attempt to put the songs in a very singable key.
