Mission Kids is a great place to meet other families and get involved in the lives of children ages 3-1/2 to 5th grades. Our focus at Mission Kids is:

What do Mission Kids workers do?

We are confident that anyone can use his/her gifts to serve with children on Sunday evenings! Some of the team member roles at Mission Kids include:

- ☆ Bible Teachers in large group
- Small Group Leaders, working with 6-10 children
- ☆ Activity/Game Leaders
- ☆ Musicians/Worship Leaders

How often would I serve at Mission Kids?

Mission Kids team members serve on four rotating teams, approximately once per month, September-July. Curriculum is provided, and we hope to focus on a different Parkside missionary or missionary biography on the first Sunday of each month.

How old do workers need to be to serve at Mission Kids?

We ask that team members be at least in 6th grade. Pre-teen, teens and adults welcome! Pre-teens (ages 11-12) must have a parent serve with them. Students 13 years and older may serve without a parent.
