Romans 6:1-14

How might you answer someone who says that it is no big deal for a Christian to sin, since grace will "abound" and cover that sin?
Why do you think Paul refers to Baptism in verse 3? Does this reference confuse or concern you? In your own words, what is Paul saying in these verses?
In our passage for this week, what are some results of believers being united to Christ in both his death and his resurrection?
What does Paul mean by telling us to 'consider yourselves dead to sin and alive to God in Christ Jesus' (v11)?
What response does Paul call for in verses 12-14?
What are two reasons that Christ gave himself for us, as written in Titus 2:11-14, especially verse 14?
