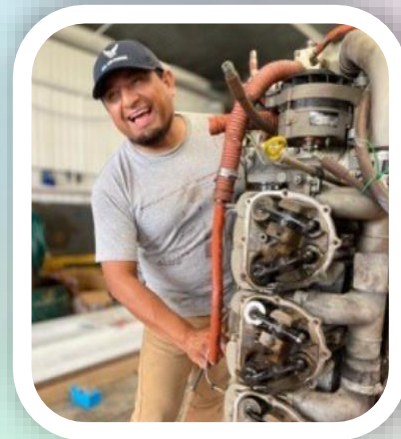

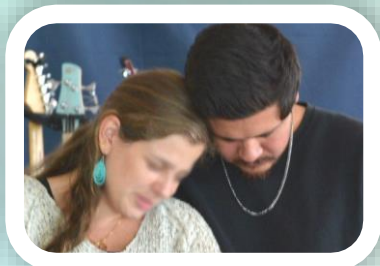
Dear Friends,
