What do you think Paul meant in verse 13 by telling the Thessalonians to not grow weary in "doing good"? Is this a particular struggle for you right now? If so, why? Be specific.

Why is the benediction of verse 16 so appropriate for the Thessalonians in light of their struggles and context? How is it appropriate for us today?

What do you think is the purpose of Paul's closing greeting in 3:17? (cf. 2:1-2)

Spend some time reflecting on what you've learned from this semester in 1 & 2 Thessalonians. What are the major lessons you'll take away?
