- 1. Read Jn 11:1-16 What do you learn about Jesus' relationship with Lazarus' family (v5)? How does was Jesus' response to the report that Lazarus was ill compare with Jesus' comments about the man born blind in John 9:1-5?
- 2. Read Luke 1-:38-42 and John 11:20-37. What do we learn about Martha and Mary from these passages? Contrast Martha's and Mary's responses to Jesus' arrival at Bethany. What are the similarities? What are the differences?
- 3. What is Jesus' reaction to Lazarus' death? (Jn 11:11-15; 38-44) What is the reason Jesus gives for being absent when Lazarus died (see v15)
