Romans 12:9-21

1. What is the prerequisite for the exhortations that Paul gives us in verses 9-21? (see 12:1-3)

2. Each of the exhortations that Paul gives has to do with relationships.
 - A. What does Paul say is the motivation behind his exhortations?

 - B. What word does Paul use to describe that motivation (v 9)?

 - C. Why do you think Paul uses that word and what are its implications?

3. What is the basis for a Christian's discernment of Good and Evil?
 - A. How is the Christian's discernment of good and evil different from the society at large?

 - B. What must a person do to recognize the difference?

 - C. Has this study impacted your personal evaluation of Good and Evil in the world, if so, how?

4. Verses 9-13 deal with New Relationships, with one another. Make a list of the encouragements found there and which ones impact you the most personally?

5. Verses 14-21 deal with New Relationships with your enemies. (Notice that revenge is not an option)
How do these verses cause you to think differently about a problem or situation you may find yourself in this week?

6. What changes are you going to make, with the Holy Spirit's power, in your life in light of this week's study
