FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ABOUT SERVING

Each summer in July, Parkside Church partners with Ambassadors Football to host a Christ-centered soccer camp for children. The camp runs from Tuesday-Saturday, with Saturday being a day for parents and friends to come enjoy soccer games and individual skills competitions.

Who can serve at the camp?

Adults and teens ages 13+ can serve.

What do helpers do at the camp?

We need assistance with the following:

- Registration/Check-in table
- Camp set-up & clean-up (tables, water coolers, ice, etc....)
- Coaches Lunch Preparation
- Daily Camp clean-up

What time do helpers arrive/leave camp?

Depending on what responsibilities helpers have, they usually arrive at 8:30am and stay either through lunch or until camp ends at 3:00pm.

I work during the week; is there any help needed on Saturday?

YES! Saturday is a "Family Day," and we need kitchen helpers to prepare the lunch for the families. Kitchen helpers are usually asked to serve from 10am-12:30pm.
