Mission Kids is a great place to meet other families and get involved in the lives of children ages 3-1/2 to grade 3. Our focus at Mission Kids is:

- to go and tell others

What do Mission Kids volunteers do?

We are confident that anyone can use his/her gifts to serve with children on Sunday evenings! Some of the team member roles at Mission Kids include:

- Bible Teachers in large group
- Room helpers, job-sharing tasks (check-in/check-out of children, activity pages, Bible time, etc.)
- ☆ Activity/Game Leaders
- ☆ Musicians/Worship Leaders in Assembly

How often would I serve at Mission Kids?

Mission Kids volunteers serve on rotating teams, approximately once every three weeks, mid-September-June. Curriculum is provided.

How old do workers need to be to serve at Mission Kids?

We ask that team members be at least in 4th grade. Pre-teen, teens and adults welcome! Pre-teens (ages 10-12) **must** have a parent serve with them. Students 13 years and older may serve without a parent.
