Exodus 28-31

1. How were the Priests selected and what was their function? (See Lev 10:10-11; Heb 5:1-2)

2. What you learn from the Lord's specificity and symbolism in His instructions for the Priest's garments.

3. The entirety of Exodus chapter 29 describes in detail how Aaron and the other priests were to be consecrated or set aside for God's use. Describe the Lord's instructions regarding:

a. Ceremonial Washings

b. Anointing with Oil

c. Animal Sacrifices

d. Eating of a sacrificial meal

e. Why is this consecration of the Priests necessary?

f. Has He called you to be set aside for His use? What do you need to do to be consecrated to the Lord?

4. Read Ex 30:11-16. What is the price and significance of the Census Tax? Who were to pay it?

5. In chapter 31, God is very specific in calling Bezalel and Oholiab to work in gold, silver and bronze. What does he say about these two men in verse 3? How are you using your God given gifts to serve God?

6. What does this lesson teach us about:

a. The Holiness of God?

b. Access to God

7. How has this lesson increased your understanding of what it means for Jesus to be our High Priest?
