Pray for me as I seek to rely on Jesus to transform me”. Keep praying for pastors and church leaders like this man, that they will grow in Christ, experiencing deep and true gospel transformation.

Our hope is not in our own goodness or in the vain expectation that God will grade on the curve. - Pray for our ESI Africa leader (Paulo Da Silva) working with Isaac Chitibwe (Lusaka, Zambian pastor). Pray that God will use Paulo and Isaac to encourage and strengthen ESI groups across Africa.
