2.	What is happening in Moses as revealed through this progression? Whom does Moses foreshadov and why is it important?
3.	Read 33:14-17. What is Moses' response to God when God says he will not go with the people? What differentiates God's people from all the other people of the earth? What is God's ultimate response to Moses' request and what reason does God give for his response. What does God's response mean to you personally?
4.	What is God's answer when Moses asks to see God's Glory? Paul in Romans 9 quotes verse 19:15. What is God saying here? Why can Moses not see God's Face? How does God reveal His glory?
	(See Ex 33:19; 34:5-8).

5.	What is Moses' response to God's Revelation of Himself? What is <u>your</u> response to God's revelation of Himself?
6.	What is the significance of the repetition of the Law in chapter 34:10-28 and the command to Moses to "write" in verses 27-28, which comes after the people breaking the Covenant by worshiping the golden calf? What is God saying and doing? Why is this meaningful to us today?
7.	Compare the people's response to Moses' return from the mountain in ex 23:30 and Ex 33:18. What is the difference? What is the proper response and why? In what ways does Moses foreshadow Jesus?
8.	This portion of Exodus is one of the most well known in all of the scriptures. What have you learned or how has your thinking changed after this week's study?
