ESI Pastors Conferences

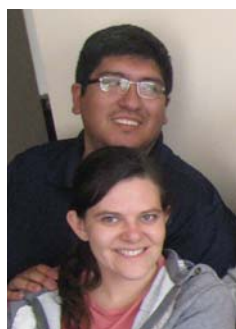
