

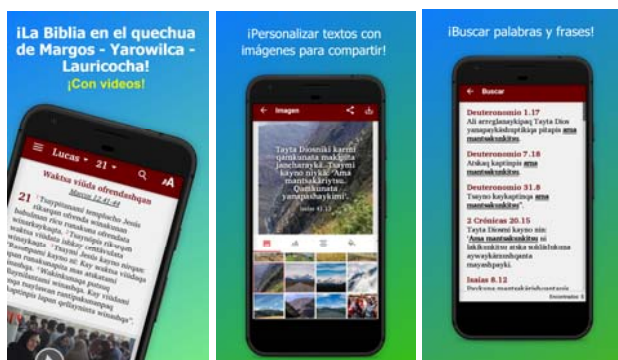
# The Beans'Talk

Update from Mark and Patti Bean

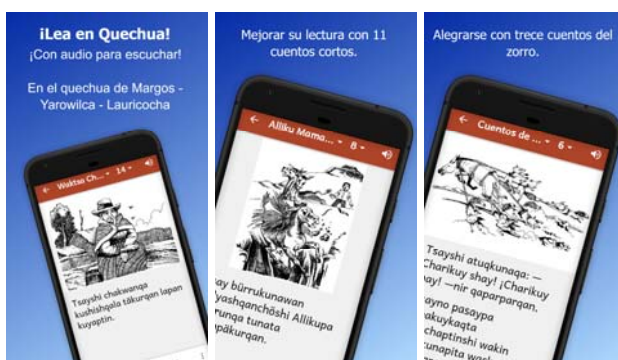
Bible translation consultant and providing biblical materials for Quechua churches in central Peru
