

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ABOUT SERVING

G.E.O. Kids is a midweek ministry for boys and girls in grades 1-5. Our focus is on personal Christian growth, friendship, service outreach, and evangelism. Our desire is that kids would come to know, love, and follow the Lord Jesus Christ and would seek to share the gospel with their friends.

**When does G.E.O. Kids meet?** We meet 2x/month on Thursdays from 7:00-8:15 pm, beginning in mid-September and going through mid-May each year. A calendar will be posted on the website each year with meeting dates.

We hope to resume G.E.O. Kids once all our Sunday Children's Ministries are fully staffed (AM & PM services).

## Who can serve at G.E.O. Kids?

Parents, grandparents, people without children in GEO Kids (married and single) are encouraged to serve. G.E.O. Kids is primarily a parent-supported ministry.

## What are some ways I can be involved with G.E.O Kids?

- Small Group Leader at GEO meetings (2x/month)—2 leaders per group; simple lesson plans, games, and snacks provided!
- Assist at our Boys' Game Nights or Girls' Craft Nights (approx. 3x/year)
- Assist at our "Service Saturdays" with set-up, clean-up, bringing materials, working with children, etc. (approx. 2x/year)

## Do I have to be a member of Parkside Church to serve at G.E.O. Kids?

You do not have to be a member; however, we do ask that you have been in regular attendance at Parkside for a minimum of 6 months. Anyone who serves at G.E.O. Kids must complete a church testimony application and a background check (workers 18+ years of age).
