Our ILC church organized a Christmas gift project for 100 children in one of the marginal communities around La Paz, where we were able to show the love of Jesus. Lucho Kama explained why Jesus came to earth — that He was born to save us from our sins by His life and death.



New believers baptized

In mid-December I had the joy of baptizing 11 people at ILC. The photo below shows me with 7 members of one family after they were baptized. They had been involved at a weekly discussion in a religious group for several years. Recognizing that it was low on Bible-content, every week they would take the study guide home and look at the verses listed in the footnotes. It was through their own study of God's Word that their hearts and minds were opened to their need for Christ's forgivingness and grace. A growing concern over doctrinal and practical errors of this group led them to leave and look for a church that was serious about teaching and living the Scriptures. In time God led them to our church. Under the constant study of the Word on Sundays and in their homes, God led them to faith in Christ. One Sunday they came to me after church and said, "We believe God wants us to be baptized"!! Its been so encouraging seeing evidences of God's grace in their lives.
