Review

In chapter 1 Peter has explained to us the growing nature of faith in the true knowledge of God and that the source of the true knowledge of God is found in the apostolic teachings of the gospel that are now found in the New Testament and the prophetic teachings found in the Old Testament. In chapter 2 he warns us of the destructiveness of false teachings about God. First, he reveals to us the characteristics of false teachers, then he reveals the condemnation of false teachers.
