1. Try to summarize in your own words what has happened so far in Isaiah 1-12. Use the chapter divisions or summarize through ideas and themes you see.
2. Read verses 1-5. Who is God using? Specifically in verse 3, for what purpose is God using this nation?
3. Read verses 6-10. Describe in detail the "day of the Lord."
4. For what is the nation of Babylon condemned for? Can you think of a story in Scripture where we see this specifically play out in a person? (Hint: cf. Daniel 4:28ff)
5. What will Babylon's end ultimately be? How is it described? Why do you think Isaiah is so detailed in his description?
