- 1. Jesus Before Pilate: Read Matthew 27:1-26 and Mark 15:1-15. From these verses, what was the real reason the Jewish leaders brought Jesus to Pilate?**
 - a. What was Judas' response to Jesus being taken to Pilate?**
 - b. What were the warnings Pilate received and how did Pilate deal with Jesus? Why do you think Pilate gave in to the crowd?**
 - c. In what way was Barabbas the one person who truly understood what Jesus had done for him?**
- 2. Read Lev 4:12,21,29; Deut 21:22-23. What was the reason that the Jews desired Jesus to be crucified outside the city of Jerusalem? From Heb 13:11-13, what is its meaning to us?**
- 3. Read Psalm 22. List the verses in this psalm that are prophetic of the sufferings of Jesus on the cross. Apply them to their fulfillment or meaning in His crucifixion.**

4. Read Heb 9:2-8, MAT 27:50-51; The temple separated the Holy Place from the Most Holy Place where God's presence was said to dwell. Only the High priest was allowed to enter within the curtain and only bearing the blood of a sacrificial lamb. What is the significance TO US that the curtain was torn in two from top to bottom when "Jesus yielded up His spirit"?

5. How do the following verses explain to us what Jesus accomplished in His death on the Cross?
 - a. Isaiah 53:4-6

 - b. 2 Cor 5:21

 - c. Heb 9:28
