TEAM: I met Daniel (in royal blue) on a TREC (our training course) in South Africa in 2005. He has faithfully served in his home country in Mozambique ever since. We are thankful for men and women like Daniel who work in difficult countries with limited resources. It is a privilege to come alongside him and many others to help them reach the next generation with the Gospel.
