  - B. Reconciliation
  - C. Obedience
  - D. Access to God
  - E. Relationship
  - F. Holiness

*3.* In verses 9-15, what were the people to do in preparation for hearing from God? What limits were given them? Why were these preparations necessary?

4. God is not silent. What does Verse 9 say God is going to do and for what purpose? How do Ex 19:9 and 20:1 affect your pre-conceived notions about <u>HOW</u> the Commandments were given to God's people?

5. In Ex 20:20 there are two kinds of fear mentioned. Can you explain the difference between them and what each one does to a person?

6. What is the promise God makes in Ex 20:24 and what does it mean to you?
