Discussion Questions

- 1. Our memories tell us that Chapter 37 is identical to Chapter 25 and we may wonder why it is necessary to repeat all the same details in this second list. What has happened between the two lists? (see Ex 32:9-10; 34:9)
- 2. Repetition is important in understanding the Scriptures. What is the governing principle for the whole Tabernacle endeavor expressed in Ex 35:1? How often is that principle repeated in this week's lesson (Chapters 35-38)? What is its significance?
- 3. What was the first command given by Moses to the people after he assembled them and before taking contributions for the tabernacle? Why is this order important? (Hint: Who was it that celebrated the Sabbath and why is it significant?)

- 4. What strikes you about the description of the materials and the skills used in the construction of the Tabernacle?
- 5. What was to be the motivation of those who provided the materials and the skills necessary for the building of the tabernacle? What was the ultimate result of this huge endeavor?(See Ex 36:6). How does this apply to the Lord's work today?
- 6. Why is the construction of the Tabernacle important to the Israelites? What does the Tabernacle foreshadow? Where is the Tabernacle in the New Testament?
