1.	Read Mat 23:1-39. What does Jesus repeatedly call the leaders in mat 2? How do verses 1-7 demonstrate that this is true? How does this problem show up in our own lives today?
2.	Summarize the prominent issues Jesus addresses in his seven "woes'" in Mat 23:13-16
3.	Do you see yourself in any of the prominent issues presented in these woes?
4.	How does Jesus' lamentation in Mat 23:37-39 inform us about how Jesus thinks and feels about those who reject him?

5.	Read Matthew 24. What is Jesus' response to the Disciples admiration of the Temple buildings? What does his response foreshadow and what is its significance to us today?
6.	What does Jesus say will happen as a sign of His return at the end of the age? Why hasn't Jesus returned yet? When will He return?
7.	Today we too need to be aware of false prophets who use the turmoil of the world to promote their agenda. How should we respond when the whole world seems to be falling apart?
8.	How can you live in light of the future? Have you turned to Jesus in repentance and faith?
