1. Read the message from Sennacherib, king of Assyria, in 36:4-10; 13-20 and 37:8-13. How would you characterize his view of himself? His view of the Lord? Despite the overall misdirection of his pronouncement, what truth does he include?
2. Read 37:1-7 and 37:14-20. Describe Hezekiah's response to both taunts from Assyria. Where does he place his hope and trust? What does Hezekiah desire to see happen as a result of the Lord's deliverance?
3. Read 36:5-7 and 37:21-32. What does Isaiah say will happen with regard to Assyria and the Assyrian threat?
4. Read chapters 38-39, along with 2 Kings 20 and 2 Chronicles 32:24-33. In your own words, tell the story of Hezekiah's final years—both the good and the bad.
5. Where do you place your trust? Are you tempted to trust what those around you trust? Describe a recent life issue where you had to decide whom or what you would trust.
